## Checker Pen Instructions



Here are some brief instructions for creating the checker pattern. Hopefully a picture is worth a thousand words. I did not go into great detail, just illustrated one way to create the pattern. You can create as many checkers as you wish. I have made both full-length checker pens as well as the example above.


Cut appropriate width and number of "slices". Flip each slice to alternate pattern and re-laminate


Tips - Good, square, 90 degree cuts are a must. Your pattern also must be well centered. What I mean is, the hole you drill down the length of the laminated pen blank must be as centered as possible. If off set or not centered, you will have smaller checker squares on one side of the pen and larger on the other.
